In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act protecting victims and children from sex offenders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 178K of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as most recently amended
- 2 by chapter 256 of the Acts of 2010, is hereby amended, in the introductory paragraph of
- 3 paragraph (c) of subsection (2), by inserting after the words "Federal Bureau of Investigation"
- 4 the following:--
- 5 provided, no sex offender categorized as a level 3 offender shall live in any state-owned
- 6 or operated housing or any facility contracted with the state within one mile of the property on
- 7 which any public or private school, licensed day care center, or any other child care facility is
- 8 located; nor shall said sex offender live within 1000 feet of the property on which said sex
- 9 offender's former victim or victims, or said victim's immediate family members reside or work;
- 10 nor within 1000 feet of the property on which any public or private school, licensed day care

- center, or any other child care facility is located; nor shall said sex offender accept employment
- within 1000 feet of the property on which any public or private school, licensed day care center,
- or any other child care facility is located; nor within 1000 feet of the property on which the
- offender's former victim or victims, or the victim's immediate family members reside.
