*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 235 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1994
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-Any court proceedings
- 3 necessary to satisfy an execution shall take place in the jurisdiction of the judgment holder.
