An act to further protect DCF social workers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by inserting the following section:-- Section 13N. Assaulting a DCF employee.
3 Whoever commits an assault or assault and battery on a Department of Children and Families
4 employee outside of that employees regular duties, when said employee has responsibility or
5 jurisdiction of assailant's case at DCF, said assailant shall be punished by imprisonment in the
6 house of correction for not less than 180 days nor more than 5 years, or by a fine of not less than
7 \$1,000 nor more than \$10,000, or both.
