Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6A of chapter 211B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “assistance” in line 5, the
3 following words: -- “1 elected clerk of the court chosen by the superior court clerk’s association,
4 1 district court clerk chosen by the district court clerk’s association.”
