An Act relative to OIS investigations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding and general or special law to the contrary, any bargaining
2 unit 8 Department of Correction employee under investigation of the Office of Investigative
3 Services shall receive no less than 10 written days notice and shall have the right to union
4 representation present at all aspects of said investigation.
