## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act regulating chapter 136..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 16 of chapter 136 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the sentence
- 2 "(T)he performance of labor, business and work directly connected to retail sales on these days
- 3 shall also be allowed" the following:
- 4 and the provisions of clause (50) of section six of chapter one hundred and thirty six
- 5 pertaining to voluntariness of work and time and one half payments shall apply to these
- 6 employees.
