In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a teen minimum wage to encourage seasonal employment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 151, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph the following:
- This section shall not apply to workers under the age of twenty who are seasonally
- 4 employed for no more than 5 months in any consecutive twelve month period. A wage of less
- 5 than \$6.00 for any such worker under the age of twenty shall conclusively be presumed to be
- 6 oppressive and unreasonable, unless the commissioner has expressly approved or shall expressly
- 7 approve the establishment and payment of a lesser wage under the provisions of sections seven
- 8 and nine.
