An Act to repeal the medical peer review statute.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1

2           Section 204 of chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 first four paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

4           No proceeding, report or record of a medical peer review committee obtained hereunder  
5 and disclosed in an action pursuant to section eighty-five N of chapter two hundred and thirty-  
6 one or a proceeding before an administrative body, shall be subject to subpoena or discovery, or  
7 introduced into evidence in judicial or administrative proceedings.
