An Act relative to the definition of a pharmacy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 112, section 39C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2005  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the word “infusion,” in place of the word  
3 fusionist, everywhere that the word fusionist appears in this section, and replacing the last  
4 sentence of this section with the following sentence:

5           “For the purposes of this section, the term home infusion pharmacy shall mean a  
6 pharmacy which dispenses pharmaceuticals, sterile intravenous drugs and nutritional products  
7 ordered by physicians to patients in their homes and other similar institutional sites of care as  
8 determined by the board.”
