An Act to allow hunting on Sunday within the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 57 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby repealed. Sunday  
2 hunting shall be allowed in the month of December and the Division of Fisheries and Wildlife  
3 may promulgate such rules and regulations as it deems necessary for the implementation and  
4 administration of this section.
