An Act to support the infiltration/inflow financial assistance program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1.       Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the  
2 contrary, the Commonwealth, by and through the state treasurer, shall reimburse the  
3 Massachusetts Water Resources Authority for its costs in providing cities and towns within its  
4 sewer service area, financial assistance in the form of interest free grants and loans to rehabilitate  
5 their collection systems, to structurally reduce infiltration and inflow that is the tributary to the  
6 treatment facilities owned by the Authority and located on Deer Island and Nut Island.
