Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (b) of section 2 of chapter 32A as most recently amended in
2 chapter 130 of the acts of 2008 is hereby amended by adding after the words “of Suffolk
3 County” the following:

4 “...persons who are employed by private human service providers that deliver
5 human and social services under contracts with the office of the Department of Housing and
6 Community Development.”
