An Act relative to property tax exemptions for renewable power systems.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 5 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition is  
2 hereby amended by adding a new sentence at the end of clause Forty-fifth:--

3           “Placement of any such system or device on property otherwise exempt from tax under  
4 this chapter shall not cause such property to become taxable.”
