An Act relative to tax credits for residents in manufactured housing communities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. subsection (i) Section 6 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws is amended by  
2 inserting the following new subsection:-

3 Subsection (i1) For the safety and welfare of residents in Manufactured Housing  
4 Communities in the Commonwealth, each resident shall receive a tax credit up to the sum of  
5 \$1,500 in order to remove oil tank(s) owned by them that are above ground and need  
6 replacement due to the health and safety of said residency; such replacement must be according  
7 to Massachusetts guidelines.
