An Act studying the special education circuit breaker reimbursement program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding Massachusetts General Laws the Treasurer of the Commonwealth shall  
2           conduct a study to determine how lottery revenues or other revenue sources can be used to bring  
3           the Special Education Circuit Breaker program up to full funding levels.

4           The Treasurer shall report back the findings to the Executive Office of Administration  
5           and Finance and the House and Senate Ways and Means Committee within 180 days of the  
6           passage of the bill.
