An Act relative to special license plates for certain military personnel..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 official edition is  
2 hereby amended by adding after the word “recipient” in line 418 the following language:

3           The registrar shall also furnish without charge to owners of private passenger motor  
4 vehicles and motorcycles who are on active duty and who received the Silver Star, the Bronze  
5 Star, Distinguished Flying Cross, or Purple Heart a plate with an emblem representing the  
6 awarding of said Silver Star, Bronze Star, Distinguished Flying Cross, or Purple Heart upon  
7 presentation by the applicant of sufficient documentation of receipt of such award.
