An Act relative to motor fuels.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 64E of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding  
2   at the end thereof the following: -

3           “Any excise or tax on motor fuel paid by a department or agency of any city or town in  
4   the Commonwealth to suppliers of motor fuels within the Commonwealth shall be reimbursed to  
5   said city or town on an annual basis. The commissioner or revenue shall promulgate rules and  
6   regulations to record and account for the total amounts of fuel purchased, means to verify said  
7   purchases and a timely method to reimburse said funds to municipalities on an annual basis  
8   through the so-called “Cherry Sheets”.”
