An Act to clarify farm plates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection:-
- 3 (5)(I) Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or specific law to the contrary, the
- 4 registrar is hereby authorized and directed to issue farmer general registration number plates for
- 5 terms of not less than three years, and to set the expiration date of such farmer general
- 6 registration number plates in the months of January, February, or March.
