An Act relative to hunting licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of the third paragraph of section 11 of chapter 131 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding its following
3 clause:—

4 (3) a resident of the commonwealth on active duty in the armed forces of the United
5 States who is stationed outside the commonwealth.
