### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to improving handicapped accessibility.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 13A of chapter 22 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "regulation" on line 96, the following:-
- 3 ", except as applies to social service agencies and programs which receive state funds
- 4 who must become handicapped accessible within 5 years of the date of passage of this bill."
