An Act relative to cueing and supervision in the PCA program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: Section 12 of chapter one hundred and eighteen E as so appearing, is hereby  
2 amended in the first paragraph by inserting at the end thereof the following new sentence:-

3           “Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the  
4 division shall develop or amend any standards and regulations applicable to the personal care  
5 attendant program to include as eligible members those individuals who are otherwise eligible  
6 for said program, but who require supervision and cueing in order to perform two or more  
7 activities of daily living.”
