## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the sale of alcoholic beverages to minors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Section 34 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

Any person selling alcoholic beverages to a minor shall be punished as follows: for a first offense a fine of \$50; for a second offense a fine of \$100; for a third offense a fine of \$250 and for a subsequent offense a fine of \$2000. Any person fined shall have a hearing and appeal for said offense through the alcoholic beverages control commission and all persons found responsible shall be a matter of public record.
