Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 105 the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 105A. Notwithstanding section 105, a person, firm, partnership, corporation or

4 other business entity that accepts a credit card for a business transaction must require a photo

- 5 I.D. as a requirement of the business transaction. For the purposes of this section credit card
- 6 shall include a debit card.
