By Mr. Atsalis of Barnstable, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2787) of Demetrius J. Atsalis for legislation to establish construction trust funds and regulating the use of such funds for improvements to property. Housing.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Eleven
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An Act establishing a construction trust fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new section:-

3 149: 29F Express Construction Trust - 1 to 4 Dwelling Units

4 The proceeds of all payments made under a contract by the owner of any building project,
5 containing or designed to contain at least one but not more than four dwelling units, to any
6 contractor or any subcontractor for improvements upon said real property shall be held in trust
7 by the contractor or subcontractor, as trustee, for the amount of all claims due or to become due
8 or owing from the contractor or subcontractor for building materials, tools and equipment used
9 for the improvements, until all said claims have been paid.

10 The express trust shall be effective against and shall have priority over any interest of a
11 party seeking payment from such contractor or subcontractor for claims other than those that are
12 due and owing by reason of the specific building project for which the trust was created, whether

13 such creditors are foreign attachment or other judicial lien creditors, a trustee in bankruptcy, or
14 similar creditors or representatives or creditors of the contractor or subcontractor.

15 Any contractor or subcontractor who knowingly retains or used the funds held in trust
16 under this section or any part thereof, for any purpose other than to pay those for whom the
17 moneys are held in trust, shall be liable to any person who successfully enforces his or her rights
18 under this section for all damages sustained by that person. This paragraph shall not apply to any
19 agent or employee of such entity that is not responsible for the proper application of such
20 amounts under this section. Except as otherwise provided herein, this section does not create a
21 civil cause of action against any person other than the contractor or subcontractor to whom such
22 funds are paid.

23 If the contractor or subcontractor is a corporation, limited liability company, or other
24 legal entity other than a sole proprietorship, the officers, directors, members, partners, or agents
25 may be deemed responsible for any misappropriation. Any of such misappropriated funds which
26 have been received as salary, dividend, loan repayment, capital distribution or otherwise by any
27 shareholder, member, or partner not responsible for the misappropriation shall be a civil liability
28 of that person and may be recovered and restored to the trust fund specified in this section by
29 action brought by any interested party for that purpose.

30 Any provision in a contract for construction which purports to waive or limit any
31 provisions of this section shall be void and unenforceable.
