An Act increasing penalties for cruelty to animals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 77 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 19, the number “5” and inserting in
3 place thereof the following number:- 10

4 SECTION 2. Section 77 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby further amended
5 by striking out, in line 21, the amount “\$2,500” and inserting in place thereof the following
6 amount:- \$5,000
