Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 12-13, the words ", or is granted a continuance without a finding".

SECTION 2. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 23 , the words ", or is granted a continuance without a finding".

SECTION 3. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 167-168, the words "except for dispositions under section twenty-four D".

SECTION 4. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 753-754, the words ", or is granted a continuance without a finding".
