## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to motor vehicle owner responsibility.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, at the end, the following new subdivision:
- 3 (6) Whoever, being the owner or custodian of a motor vehicle, allows another person to
- 4 operate said motor vehicle upon any way or in any place to which the public has a right of access
- 5 or upon any way or in any place to which members of the public shall have access as invitees or
- 6 licensees, and said operation results in property damage or personal injury in which the operator
- 7 of the vehicle has left the scene of the accident without stopping and making known his or her
- 8 name, residence, and the registration number of the motor vehicle he is driving, shall be punished
- 9 by a fine of not less than \$200.00 nor more than \$1,000.
