Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1, Subsection of Section 1 of Chapter 201B of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended as follows: by adding at the end thereof a new
- 3 sentence as follows:
- 4 "any person acting under a durable power of attorney shall have an obligation to act in
- 5 good faith towards the principal who conferred the power."
- 6 Section 2, Chapter 201B of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 7 section 5 as now appearing a new section as follows:
- 8 "5A. A person exercising authority under a durable power of attorney shall be liable for
- 9 deliberate breach of their fiduciary duty."
