An Act relating to the distributing the Conflict of Interest Law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 SECTION 1. Section 27 of Chapter 268A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking out the words " county and municipal" after the phrase "every state".

5 SECTION 2. Section 27 of Chapter 268A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
6 inserting at the end of the paragraph the following new sentence:-

8 "Every county and municipal employee shall, within 30 days of becoming such an
9 employee, and upon any instances of changes of this chapter thereafter, be furnished with a
10 summary of this chapter prepared by the commission and sign a written acknowledgment that he
11 has been provided with such a summary."
