- 1 Section 10 of Chapter 269 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended in subsection (j) by inserting following the words "by whatever means," the
- 3 words:- "and 'dangerous weapon' shall mean any other instrument reasonably believed to cause
- 4 bodily harm."
