*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Chapter 90, Section 13A of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008  
2   Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out the words in lines 25 through 27,"...and any  
3   person sixteen years of age or over who rides as a passenger in a motor vehicle without wearing  
4   a safety belt."
