An Act establishing uniform wage compliance and recordkeeping.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 150 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “benefits,” in line 27, the  
3   following words:-

4           ; provided, however, that the 3-year limitation period shall be tolled from the date that the  
5   employee or a similarly situated employee files a complaint with the attorney general alleging a  
6   violation of any of these sections until the date that the attorney general issues a letter  
7   authorizing a private right of action or the date that an enforcement action by the attorney general  
8   becomes final.

9           SECTION 2. Section 15 of chapter 151 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
10   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 6, the word “two” and by inserting  
11   after the word “least,” in line 6, the following word:-

12           three.

13           SECTION 3. Section 20A of chapter 151 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
14 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the word “two,” and by inserting  
15 after the word “than,” in line 2, the following word:-

16           three.

17           SECTION 4. Said section 20A of said chapter 151, as so appearing, is hereby further  
18 amended by inserting after the word “action,” in line 3, the following words:-

19           ; provided, however, that the limitation period shall be tolled from the date that the  
20 employee or a similarly situated employee files a complaint with the attorney general alleging a  
21 violation of this chapter until the date that the attorney general issues a letter authorizing a  
22 private right of action or the date that an enforcement action by the attorney general becomes  
23 final.
