An Act reducing the Commonwealth's unfunded healthcare liability.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Subdivision (1) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most
2	recently amended by chapters 21and 25 of the Acts of 2009, is hereby further amended by
3	inserting after paragraph (n) the following new paragraph:
4	(n) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, members hired after
4 5	(n) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, members hired after January 1, 2012 who are classified in Group 1 and Group 2 shall complete twenty years or
