Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, a

member who is receiving a lesser retirement allowance in accordance with the terms of Option

3 b or Option C of Subdivision of Section (to be filled in by filer) of Chapter 32 of the General

4 Laws, from a retirement system that accepts the provisions of this act, shall have his retirement

5 allowance determined according to the table of mortality selected by the commission pursuant to

6 Section 336 of Chapter 47 of the Acts of 2004 and whatever section governs the Option B

7 amount. For purposes of the Act, the State Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement Systems

8 shall be deemed to have accepted the provisions of this act.
