An Act relative to authorizing a local option for group classification.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after line 307
- 3 the following new paragraph:-
- 4 Any municipality or public authority may elect to improve the retirement group
- 5 classification for any group of employees of the municipality or the public authority upon its
- 6 acceptance in the following manner: in a city having a Plan D or a Plan E charter by majority
- 7 vote of its city council and approved by the manager; in any other city by majority vote of the
- 8 city council and approved by the mayor; in a town by vote of the board of selectmen; in a public
- 9 authority by majority vote of the authority governing board. Nothing in this act shall be

- 10 construed as authorization to diminish the retirement benefits of public employees by placing
- any group of employees in a lower group of classification.
