*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Sections 53, 56, 57, and 59 of chapter 27 of the acts of 2009 are hereby  
2 repealed.

3           SECTION 2. Section 1 shall be effective July 1, 2012.
