An Act relative to records open to public inspection.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 7 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:-

3           “All records in the custody of the state secretary which are ninety years or older shall be  
4 open to public inspection.”
