*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 16 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

3 No person shall operate a motor vehicle while using a cell phone, unless the cell phone is  
4 hands free, so called.
