An Act relative to the safety inspection of the Long Island Bridge in the city of Boston..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The City of Boston, Bridge Inspection Unit, shall perform a safety  
2   inspection of the Long Island Bridge within the City of Boston, connecting Moon Island and  
3   Long Island.

4           SECTION 2. If the bridge is deemed unsafe, the The City of Boston, is instructed to  
5   implement an alternate, economically feasible, means for transportation via water shuttle/barge  
6   access to Long Island within 90 days of inspection.
