Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The City of Boston, Bridge Inspection Unit, shall perform a safety
- 2 inspection of the Long Island Bridge within the City of Boston, connecting Moon Island and
- 3 Long Island.
- 4 SECTION 2. If the bridge is deemed unsafe, the The City of Boston, is instructed to
- 5 implement an alternate, economically feasible, means for transportation via water shuttle/barge
- 6 access to Long Island within 90 days of inspection.
