**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act relative to commercial driver licensing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 6 of Chapter 90F, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended in  
2 line 13, by inserting after the word, "vehicles", the following:

3           The registrar shall administer the tests prescribed under this section in Portuguese and  
4 Spanish, if so requested by the applicant, and in any other language the registrar deems  
5 necessary, as reasonable accommodation for limited-English speaking applicants for licenses to  
6 operate commercial motor vehicles. No test administered pursuant to Section 6 shall be used to  
7 determine any English language skills required by federal guidelines.
