An Act Relative to Parking Facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the
- 2 contrary, the office of consumer affairs and business regulations shall promulgate regulations
- 3 requiring all parking facilities, including intermodal parking facilities and garages, to display
- 4 prominently at the entrance of such a facility the following:
- 5 a)hourly parking rates
- 6 b) formulas by which final price of parking is calculated
- 7 SECTION 2. The office of consumer affairs and business regulations shall issue
- 8 instructions or forms, or promulgate rules or regulations, necessary for the implementation of
- 9 this act.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect within 90 days after its passage.
