**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act Relative to Parking Facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, the office of consumer affairs and business regulations shall promulgate regulations  
3 requiring all parking facilities, including intermodal parking facilities and garages, to display  
4 prominently at the entrance of such a facility the following:

5 a)hourly parking rates

6 b)formulas by which final price of parking is calculated

7 SECTION 2. The office of consumer affairs and business regulations shall issue  
8 instructions or forms, or promulgate rules or regulations, necessary for the implementation of  
9 this act.

10 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect within 90 days after its passage.
