An Act to allow translators for driving tests.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the third sentence, the following
3 sentence:-

4 To facilitate the examination of a non-english speaking applicant, the applicant may be
5 accompanied by an interpreter of his own choosing, whose credentials are deemed suitable to the
6 registrar, to assist in the oral and road portion of the driving test.
