An Act relative to safe driving in school speed zones.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 155 of the Acts of 2010 is hereby amended by adding,  
2 after the word "vehicle." the following:-

3           A person, regardless of age, may not use a wireless telephone at any time while operating  
4 a motor vehicle on a roadway in a school speed zone.

5           This does not apply to a person using a wireless telephone for emergency purposes,  
6 including, but not limited to, law enforcement agency, health care provider, fire department, or  
7 other emergency services agency or entity, of a law enforcement officer or operator of an  
8 emergency vehicle when performing the officer's or operator's official duties.
