## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to a junior operator seat belt requirement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8, subsection (e) of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the fifth paragraph, the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- A person holding a junior operator's license who operates a motor vehicle without a seat
- 5 belt shall be subject to a fine of twenty-five dollars. This provision shall be enforced by law
- 6 enforcement agencies and the operator may be stopped even if there is no other violation of
- 7 motor vehicle laws or any other offense.
