An Act to regulate housing for convicted sex offenders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 178F.5 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, after  
2           the last sentence of the first paragraph, the following paragraph:--

3           A sex offender finally classified as a Level 2 or Level 3 offender shall also be restricted  
4           from residing within 500 feet of school zones located within the Commonwealth of  
5           Massachusetts.
