An Act relative to the retirement of certain employees in the Department of Youth Service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3(g) of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Law is hereby  
2   amended by including the titles Youth Service Case Worker I, Youth Service Case Worker II,  
3   Youth Service Transportation Officer 1 and 2, and Group Worker 1, 2, and 3, in Group 4 of the  
4   retirement system.
