An Act providing for an income tax exemption for senior citizens.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by striking out the words “seven hundred dollars”, in lines 106 and 121, and
- 3 inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the figure:— \$3,000.
