An Act relative to the Sex Offender Registry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1: Section 178D of the Chapter 6 of the Massachusetts general laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking after the number "1", the following words " or level 2" and is further
- 3 amended by adding after subsection (ii) of said section 178D the following words at the end
- 4 thereof, ", including institutions of higher learning."
- 5 Section 2: Section 178J of the Chapter 6 of the Massachusetts general laws is hereby
- 6 amended by striking after the word "offender" the following words, ", If available".
